

**Example of Caregiver Actions to meet resident needs using EDGE Caregiver Goals on the Societal Level:**

<b>Societal Level of BASICS Need</b>	
What contacts does (s) he need to ensure that "sense of self" as an individual among others is maintained (family, group, religious, work, property, etc.)?	
<b>Examples of Action to Meet Societal Needs</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Celebrate birthday.</li> <li>2. Provide quiet place to visit with family.</li> <li>3. Assist with preparation to attend social group.</li> <li>4. Call by preferred name.</li> </ol>

<b>EDGE Caregiver Goal Questions</b>	<b>Examples Of Caregiver Action To Provide Quality Care</b>
<i>How can we:</i>	<i>When supporting the resident's role as leader at a Big Band music group:</i>
1. <i>help the resident feel safe?</i>	1. Follow the same ritual each time the group meets and be ready to cue the resident in his/her role as needed.
2. <i>help the resident feel physically comfortable?</i>	2. Adjust temperature of room, size of group and resident's clothing to one of comfort for each person in the group.
3. <i>help the resident experience a sense of control?</i>	3. Support resident to carry out role in the group in his/her own way cuing him/her for success.
4. <i>help the resident feel valued as a person?</i>	4. Praise resident for a job well done and talk about how (s)he contributed to the group's success today. Thank the resident for coming and say what you enjoyed about today's group.
5. <i>help the resident experience optimal stimulation?</i>	5. Help the resident to prepare for his/her role of leader in the group.
6. <i>help the resident experience pleasure?</i>	6. Encourage the other residents to acknowledge and praise the resident's role as leader.

<b>Document "Quality Moments" Under Societal Level of BASICS: (Those times when you witnessed that "spark of life" in the resident)</b>	
<i>For example: Henry was kidding and laughing with the other male residents during the Big Band Group held last night. He told stories about hearing the Army Band at West Point football games. "I'm an Army man, myself." This is the first time Henry joined the group and said he would like to come again.</i>	
<b>Meeting the care plan goal that Henry will actively take part in an activity he enjoys 1x per week x next 4 weeks.</b>	
<b>What other level of BASICS Needs were met for Henry through the Big Band Group?</b>	

<b>EDGE Interventions to Meet Societal Needs:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A Big Band Musical Program</li> <li>Tea Group</li> <li>Breakfast (Lunch or Supper) Club</li> <li>Social Interactions</li> <li>Environmental Influences on Agitation</li> <li>Disruptive Behavior</li> </ul>
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
