<p>Resident becomes agitated when a tub or shower bath is attempted and reacts by screaming, and striking out at staff.</p> <p>She is upset for most of the day after a bath.</p>	<p>The resident will have a more pleasant bathing experience during which she will not react with screaming or strike out at staff during bathing 2x wk. for the next 4 weeks.</p>	<p>1. Alternate ways of providing for the resident's personal hygiene will be explored to provide a more acceptable bathing experience for the resident.</p> <p>a) A unit meeting with primary caregivers will be held to identify factors in present bathing method that may cause the resident to react negatively. EDGE Gentle Bathing Worksheets will be filled out by all staff who bathe resident.</p> <p>b) Alternative bathing methods will be considered using EDGE worksheets and new approaches planned with the ID team to establish a more acceptable bathing experience.</p> <p>c) Effectiveness of the bathing plan will be evaluated at the next resident care conference.</p>	<p>Nsg.
