COMMUNITY INTEGRATION: GUEST ENTERTAINMENT

Policy:

To ensure that registrants are exposed to the outside community and are offered a variety of activities, entertainment and educational services, the activity calendar will include guest entertainment and educational services whenever possible to add interest and variety to the activities program.

Procedure:

1. The program director shall investigate resources for utilization as guest entertainment and educational services. The following are some examples:
 - a. Art experiences;
 - b. Local musicians;
 - c. College interns;
 - d. Visits from local college students;
 - e. Guest speakers;
 - f. Traveling zoo's;
 - g. Local choral groups and bands;
 - h. Pet therapy services;
2. The program director will discuss the center's needs with the potential volunteer (group).
3. The program director will schedule with the outside guest the amount of time and how often the guest will come to the center.
4. During the guest's program at the center the program director will observe the member's interest and involvement in the program/activity provided to determine the success of the guest's involvement.
