### AIDS Nursing Facilities

AIDS Nursing facilities are specifically designated nursing homes targeting services to residents with HIV/AIDS. These nursing homes must ensure special services are provided including: medical services by a physician who has experience in the care and clinical management of persons with HIV/AIDS, sub-specialty physician services, nursing services supervised by a registered professional nurse with experience in the care and management of persons with HIV/AIDS, substance abuse services, HIV risk/harm reduction education, case management and pastoral care.

### Expanded Syringe Access Program (ESAP)

Supports the provision of new, sterile syringes without a prescription to active injection drug users, steroid and hormone users and others who inject substances to prevent transmission or acquisition of blood borne diseases. Provision of syringes includes an informational insert on various safer injection practices, disposal and referrals to needed services. ESAP eligible providers are NYSDOH licensed pharmacies, health care providers (Physician, Physician Assistant, Nurse Practitioner) and Article 28 facilities.

## Harm Reduction

Individual- and group-level interventions (single-session and/or multiple-session) that address harms related to substance use—particularly the risk of HIV/STD/Hepatitis C transmission from unsafe drug-using and/or unsafe sexual behaviors. Interventions combine client-centered risk reduction education and counseling to help drug users recognize the consequences of substance use and set achievable goals toward positive behavior change. Referrals and navigation to substance use treatment and other supportive services are provided as needed.

## **HIV/STD/HCV Prevention Education/Risk Reduction Services**

Health education and risk reduction education and/or counseling services are provided to individuals and/or groups and range from targeted outreach to prevention counseling to group interventions to broad community level interventions (CLI). Individual-level interventions (ILI) provide individualized health communication, health education, and risk reduction counseling to assist clients in creating plans for individual behavior change and making ongoing appraisals of their own behavior. These interventions may consist of one or multiple sessions. Group-level interventions (GLI) may include peer education and support to promote and reinforce safer behaviors. Prevention interventions delivered to groups may be single or multiple sessions, and often provide interpersonal skills training to negotiate and sustain appropriate behavior change. CLIs seek to reduce risk behaviors by changing attitudes, norms, and practices of community members, and may include a combination of intervention types (e.g., outreach, health communication, public information) or units of delivery (e.g., individual, group, community)

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## **Individual And Group Supportive Counseling**

General counseling and support designed to assist HIV positive individuals in addressing barriers to medical care/treatment, adherence and/or prevention services. Supportive counseling can be individual or group.
