Paramedic Curriculum

On or before September 1, 2000 all approved Paramedic Education Programs must follow the *EMT-Paramedic: National Standard Curriculum* (1998).

The New York State EMS Council approved this curriculum at their May 25, 1999 meeting. Its use will be mandated for all programs starting on or after September 1, 2000.
