


- Go to <https://www.NYLearnsPH.com>

- Click “**Submit Your Registration**”

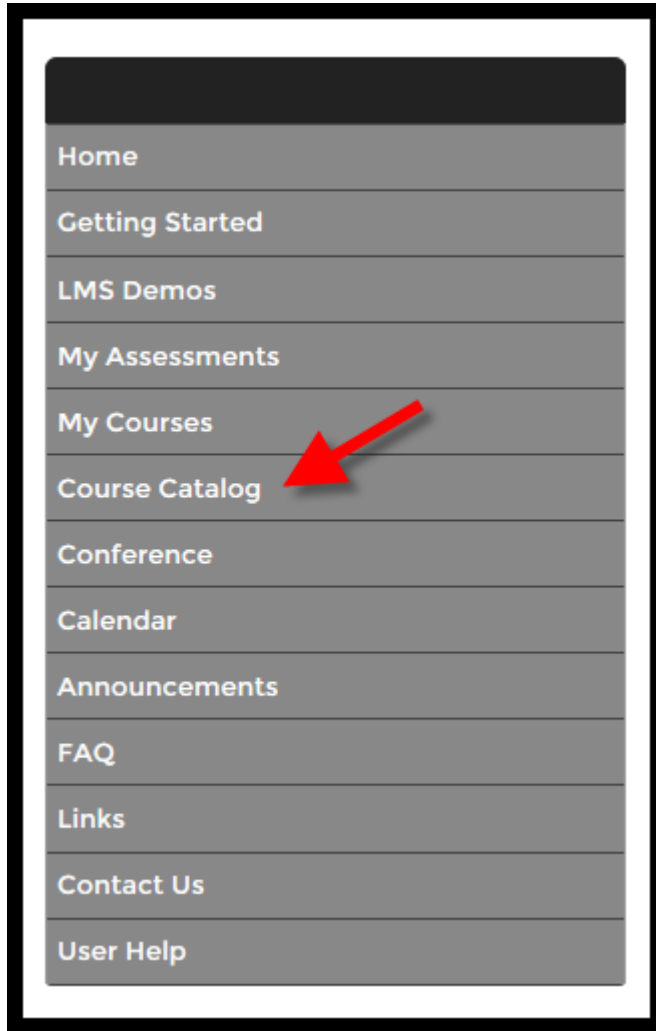


