The following are official modifications, which are hereby incorporated into the New York State Department of Health, Division of Family Health, Bureau of Administration, Early Intervention Program Monitoring and Quality Improvement Services Question and Responses, # 20047.

The RFP # 20047 was issued July 14, 2020. The information contained in this amendment prevails over the original RFP Question and Response language posted August 11,2020. For the amendment below, deleted language appears in strikethrough (\*\*\*x\*\*) and added language appears in bold, highlighted and underlined (\*\*\*x\*\*).

## Original Language:

- **20. Question:** Section 6.2 D. Technical Proposal Narrative. This section states, "Bidder's should respond to each element listed below and label their responses with the corresponding section letter/number." The section numbering is inconsistent throughout Section 6.2.D. Two examples:
  - D1 is followed by D.1.1.1, but it should be followed by D.1.1.
  - D.1.1.1.5.b, which is followed by D.1.2.a.

Question 1: Will the state revise the numbering throughout this section?

Question 2: If not, may the Bidder create a logical (but aligned to RFP) numbering system for the Technical Proposal?

Response: See the Amendment #1 to the RFP.

## Revised Language:

- **20. Question:** Section 6.2 D. Technical Proposal Narrative. This section states, "Bidder's should respond to each element listed below and label their responses with the corresponding section letter/number." The section numbering is inconsistent throughout Section 6.2.D. Two examples:
  - D1 is followed by D.1.1.1, but it should be followed by D.1.1.
  - D.1.1.1.5.b, which is followed by D.1.2.a.

Question 1: Will the state revise the numbering throughout this section?

Question 2: If not, may the Bidder create a logical (but aligned to RFP) numbering system for the Technical Proposal?
