The Medicaid Eligibility Verification System (MEVS) and

Dispensing Validation System (DVS) enable a provider

to verify member eligibility prior to the provision of services

and obtain authorization(s) for specific services covered

under DVS. A member, also known as a client, recipient,

or enrollee, must present an official Common Benefit

Identification Card (CBIC) to the provider when requesting

services. As the issuance of a CBIC does not constitute

full authorization for provision of medical services and

supplies, the member eligibility must also be verified


through eMedNY to confirm the member's subsequent

eligibility for services and supplies. A provider that

does not verify eligibility prior to provision of

services will risk nonpayment for those services.






