Category of Arrangements

Population and Episode-based

New York State developed two main categories of integrated care arrangements. The two main categories of arrangements are population and episode based. These establish the types of care that can be included in a VBP contract.

Category of Arrangement	Type of Arrangement
Population-based arrangement	Total Care for General Population
	Total Care for Special Needs Population (there are 4 Special Need Population based arrangements)
Episode-based arrangement	Maternity Care
	Integrated Primary Care, includes Chronic Care conditions

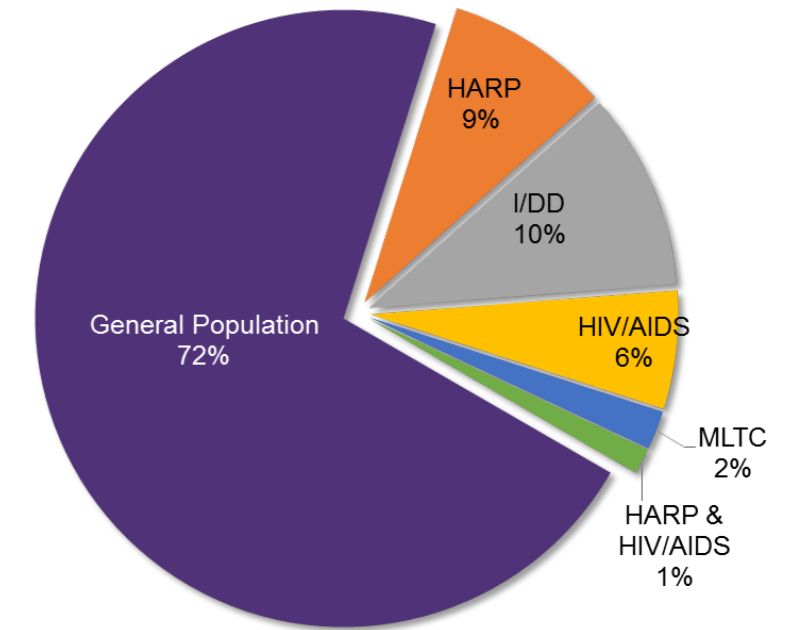
Population-based Arrangement(s)

General Population and Subpopulations

In population-based arrangements (total care and special needs sub-populations) the VBP Contractor assumes responsibility for the care of the general population (TCGP) and/or a specific subpopulation.

Arrangement	What is contracted?	For which population?
Total Care for General Population (TCGP)	Party(ies) contracted with the payer assumes responsibility for the total care of the population attributed to the arrangement	General Population (Mainstream Medicaid)
HIV/AIDS		Special needs sub-population: HIV/AIDS
Health And Recovery Plan (HARP)		Special needs sub-population: HARP eligible
Managed Long Term Care (MLTC)		Special needs sub-population: MLTC
Intellectually/ Developmentally Disabled (I/DD)		Special needs sub-population: I/DD

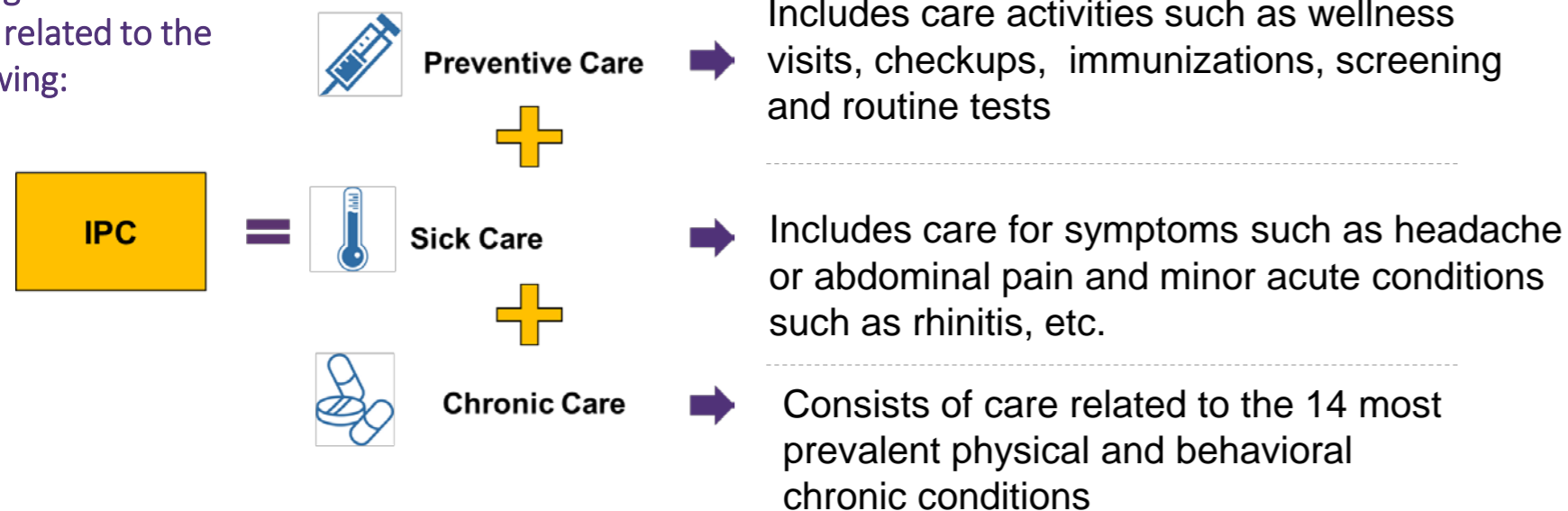
NYS 2014 Medicaid Costs & VBP Arrangement Breakdown
