

New York State - Weekly JYNNEOS Vaccination Demographic Report

Vaccinations reported to the New York State Immunization Information System (NYSIIS), as of 9/25/22

Since the [7/29/22 Executive Order](#), providers are required to report all JYNNEOS vaccinations administered into NYSIIS. Before that date, vaccination reporting was voluntary, and records for that time are incomplete and do not reflect all JYNNEOS vaccines administered to date. The numbers presented below reflect all administered first doses reported. Totals do not include vaccines administered in New York City.

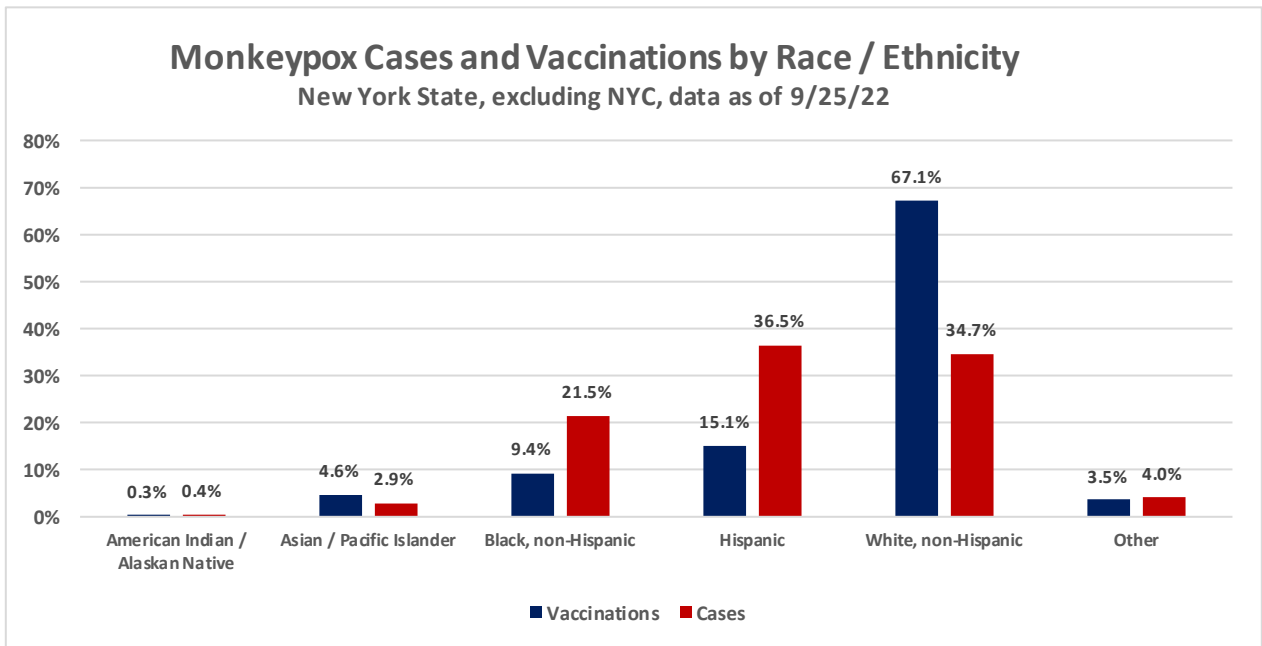
