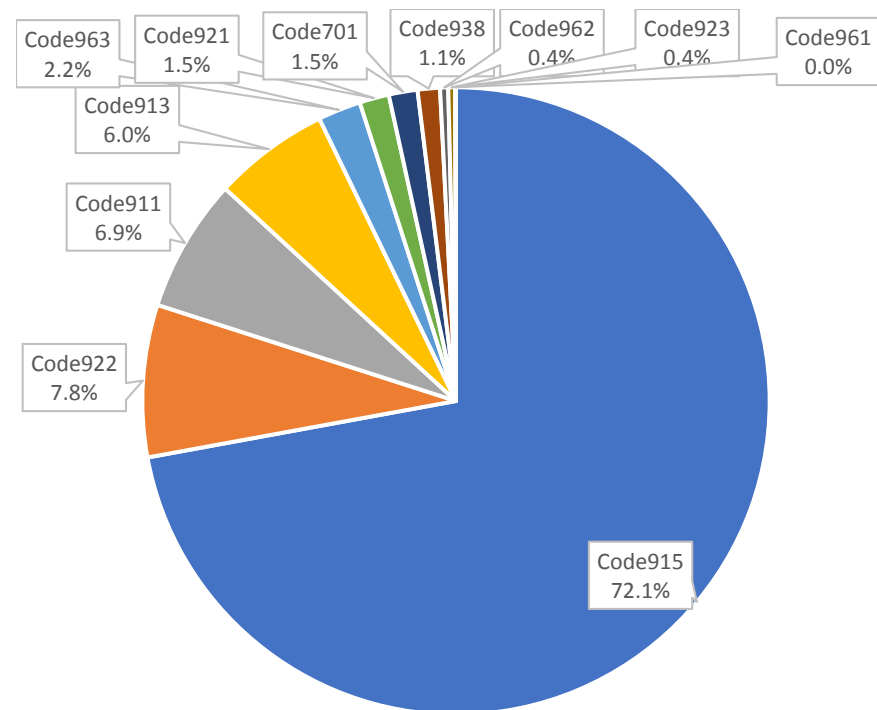

If SPARCS AS records exist, the facility's incidents are tabulated in the "ASC" category. If SPARCS AS records do not exist, the facility's incidents are tabulated in the Diagnostic & Treatment Center category.

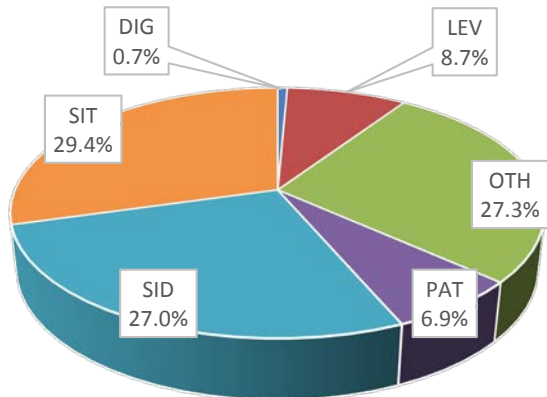

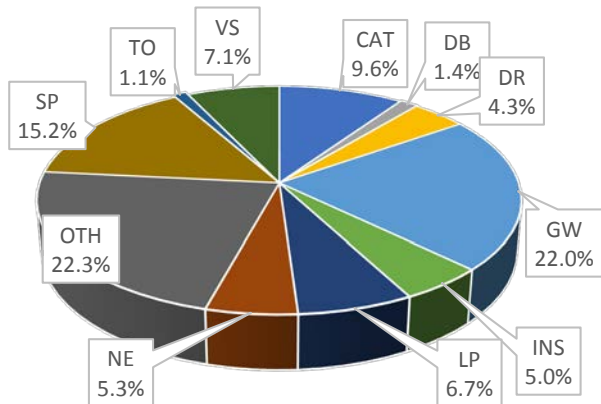

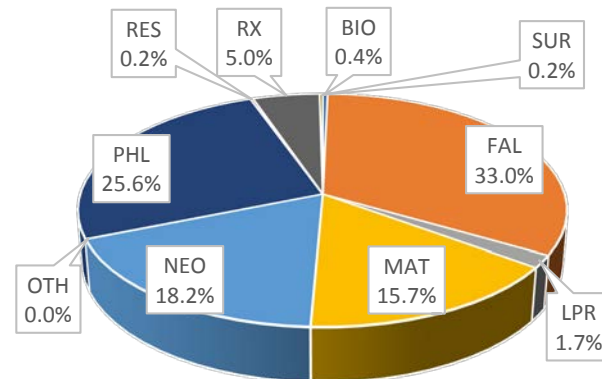

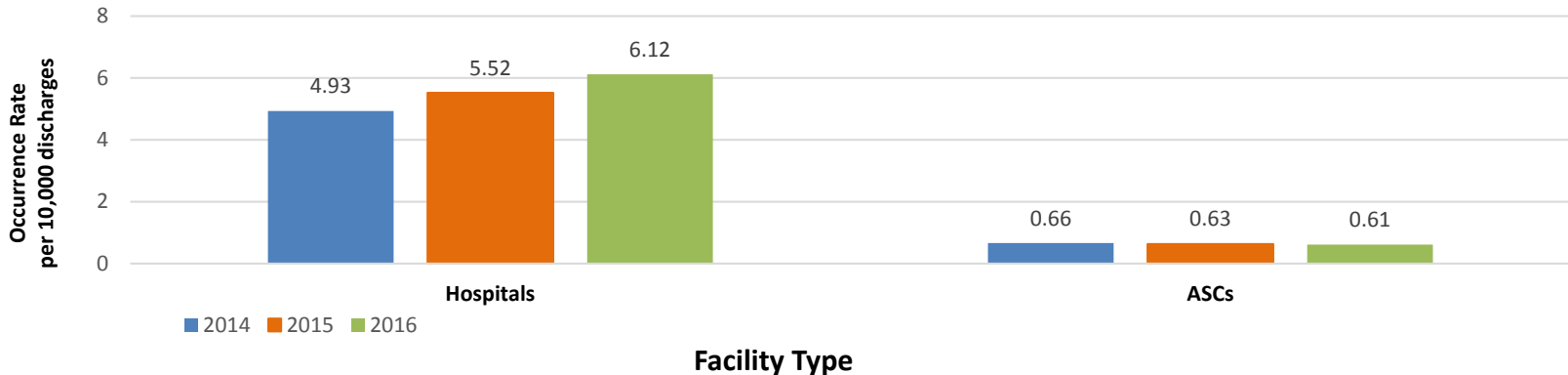

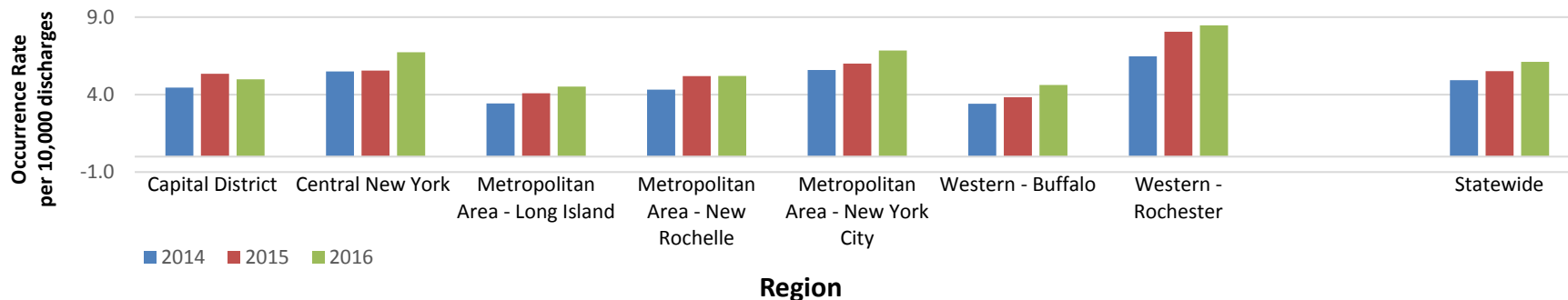
