

If the facility type in HFIS is a hospital, the NYPORTS incidents are tabulated in the "Hospital" category; if the facility type is a Diagnostic & Treatment Center, a second check is performed against the PFIs in the SPARCS Ambulatory Surgery (AS) outpatient records. If SPARCS AS records exist, the facility's incidents are tabulated in the "ASC" category. If SPARCS AS records do not exist, the facility's incidents are tabulated in the Diagnostic & Treatment Center category.




