Dear Dr. Schulman:

On behalf of New York Presbyterian/Lower Manhattan Hospital ("Hospital"), I submit the Hospital's Clinical Staffing Plan. This Staffing Plan encompasses in-patient nursing care units at the Hospital. Over the last six months Hospital management has worked collaboratively with the non-management members of the Clinical Staffing Committee discussing with them the working conditions, staffing, physical environment, available resources, census and acuity on each of these in-patient nursing units. While the Clinical Staffing Committee did not reach consensus on a plan for the Hospital the discussions we had with our non-management partners were insightful and productive, and led to enhancements and modifications to the Clinical Staffing Plan we submit to you now.

For each in-patient nursing care unit referenced in the Hospital's Clinical Staffing Plan, we have provided our last proposal and our plan for that unit in the form of a guideline, as well as the last proposal presented to the Hospital by the non-management staffing committee members. In addition, for each such unit, the Hospital has provided a brief narrative setting forth the reason(s) for our decision not to adopt, or not to adopt in whole, the non-management committee members' proposal.

In addition to the staffing enhancements indicated in the Hospital's Clinical Staffing plan we are also developing an enhanced float pool of nursing assistants and unit assistants dedicated to assist nursing units that encounter spikes in volume and acuity or other stressors. The Hospital also remains committed to supporting the nursing staff by responding to any material change in census or acuity.

In short, while the Clinical Staffing Plan we are submitting provides for safe and appropriate staffing levels and world-class patient care, we will continue to explore ways to enhance how we deliver patient care while caring for and supporting our exemplary workforce.

Narrative justification of adopted plan: The clinical staffing committee reached consensus regarding UC coverage for day and evening shifts on this unit, which is a 20 bed intensive care unit. However, the Hospital does not agree with and did not accept the recommendation from the non-management members of the clinical staffing committee to add RNs or PCTs on this unit, or UCs on the night shift. Notably the Hospital believes that current staffing and support are adequate based on census and acuity. In fact, this ICU is a silver Beacon Award for Excellence recipient that employs evidence-based practices to improve patient and family outcomes. In this quarter (to date), the ICU has been a 4 star HCAHPS unit and has 5 stars in communication with nurses and responsiveness of staff. Nursing Quality Indicators exceeded the benchmark on this unit, insofar as it has had 0 falls with injury in 2021 and 2022, 0 CLABSI, 0 CDiff, and 0 DVTs in 2022. It is important to note that there are other support personnel on this unit that aid in the provision of nursing services, including a respiratory therapist team, a rehab team, a dialysis team, a PICC team, and a team of float pool nurses, patient care technicians, and unit clerks. The need for additional staffing is further mitigated because all staff members at the Hospital are issued a mobile communication device for direct communication. In addition, the Hospital is establishing ancillary float pools composed of Unit Assistants and NAs to provide additional support to the unit.

Notably, the Hospital believes that current staffing and support are adequate based upon unit census and acuity. In fact, in this quarter (to date), this unit has been a 4 star HCAHPS unit and has 4 stars in communication about medicines and communication with nurses. Nursing Quality Indicators exceeded the benchmark on this unit, insofar as it has had 0 CLABSI, 0 CAUTI, 0 device-related HAPI in 2022, and exceeded benchmark for 4 quarters in HAPI Stage 2+. It is important to note that there are other support personnel on this unit that aid in the provision of nursing services, including a rapid response team, a respiratory therapist team, a rehab team, a dialysis team, a PICC team, and a team of float pool nurses, patient care technicians, and unit clerks. In addition, the Hospital is establishing ancillary float pools composed of Unit Assistants and NAs to provide additional support to the unit.

In fact, in this quarter (to date), this unit has been a 4 star HCAHPS unit and has 5 stars in communication with nurses. Nursing Quality Indicators exceed the benchmark on this unit, insofar as it has had 0 falls with injury, 0 CLABSI, 0 CAUTI, 0 MRSA, 0 device-related HAPI, and 0 DVTs in 2022, and exceeded benchmark for 4 quarters in HAPI Stage 2+. Narrative justification of adopted plan: Maternal Child Health Nursing at the Hospital provides family-centered care to obstetrical patient and newborns. Women from adolescence through adulthood with obstetrical health needs including ante-partum, intrapartum, and post-partum are cared for on labor and delivery and post-partum, and those requiring more than normal newborn care are admitted to the NICU. This unit is the post-partum unit and consists of 25 beds and works in tandem with a 25 bed well baby nursery.

The clinical staffing committee reached consensus regarding UC coverage on this unit. However, the Hospital does not agree with and did not accept the recommendation from the non-management members of the clinical staffing committee to add RNs or PCTs on this unit. Notably the Hospital believes that current staffing and support are adequate based on census and acuity. In fact, in this quarter (to date), this unit has been a 4 star HCAHPS unit and has 5 stars in discharge information. Nursing Quality Indicators exceed the benchmark on this unit, insofar as it has had 0 CLABSI, 0 CAUTI, 0 falls, 0 CDiff, and 0 MRSA in 2022. In addition, the Hospital is establishing ancillary float pools composed of Unit Assistants and NAs to provide additional support to the unit.

Narrative justification of adopted plan: Maternal Child Health Nursing at the Hospital provides family-centered care to obstetrical patient and newborns. Women from adolescence through adulthood with obstetrical health needs including ante-partum, intrapartum, and post-partum are cared for on labor and delivery and post-partum, and those requiring more than normal newborn care are admitted to the NICU. This unit is an 8 bed neonatal ICU that supports a level II status of acuity. The RNs on this unit are cross-trained to support NICU, post-partum and nursery.

The clinical staffing committee reached consensus regarding UC coverage during the day shift on this unit. However, the Hospital does not agree with and did not accept the recommendation from the non-management members of the clinical staffing committee to add RNs or PCTs on this unit, or UCs on the evening and night shifts. Notably the Hospital believes that current staffing and support are adequate based on census and acuity. Nursing Quality Indicators exceed the benchmark on this unit, insofar as it has had 0 falls and CLABSI in 2020, 2021, and 2022. The need for additional staffing is further mitigated because all staff members at the Hospital are issued a mobile communication device for direct communication. In addition, the Hospital is establishing ancillary float pools composed of Unit Assistants and NAs to provide additional support to the unit.

Narrative justification of adopted plan: LMH Emergency Department is the only full-service 24-hour Adult and Pediatric Emergency Department south of 14th Street and is also a Designated Stroke Center. The ED includes the largest decontamination unit in the city and is fully equipped to respond to both individual and community-wide emergencies.

The Hospital does not agree with and did not accept the recommendation from the non-management members of the clinical staffing committee to add RNs, PCTs or UCs on this unit. Notably the Hospital believes that current staffing and support are adequate based on census and acuity. The door to initial evaluation is around 10 minutes and the door to full evaluation is around 17 minutes. Our ED left without being seen rate is at 1.0%.

It is important to note that there are other support personnel on this unit that aid in the provision of nursing services, including a rapid response team, a respiratory therapist team, a rehab team, a PICC team, and a team of float pool nurses, patient care technicians, and unit clerks. The need for additional staffing is further mitigated because all staff members at the Hospital are issued a mobile communication device for direct communication. In addition, the Hospital is establishing ancillary float pools composed of Unit Assistants and NAs to provide additional support to the unit.

Narrative justification of adopted plan: Maternal Child Health Nursing at LMH provides family centered care to obstetrical patients and newborns. Women from adolescence through adulthood with obstetrical health needs including ante-partum, intrapartum, and post-partum are cared for on labor and delivery and post-partum, and those requiring more than normal newborn care are admitted to the NICU. The labor and delivery unit consists of 9 birthing rooms, 2 operating rooms, a 3 bed PACU, and a 3 bed triage area. L&D follows the AWHONN Guideline recommendations and has nurses with the following roles: charge/triage nurse, baby nurse, EMTALA nurse, OR nurse, PACU nurse, and labor room nurse.

The clinical staffing committee reached consensus regarding RN coverage for this unit. However, the Hospital does not agree with and did not accept the recommendation from the non-management members of the clinical staffing committee to add OR Techs, PSAs and UCs on this shift. Notably the Hospital believes that current staffing and support are adequate based on census and acuity. In this quarter (to date), this unit has been a 4 star HCAHPS unit. Nursing Quality Indicators exceed the benchmark on this unit, insofar as it has had 0 CLABSI, 0 CAUTI, and 0 falls in 2022. The need for additional staffing is further mitigated because all staff members at the Hospital are issued a mobile communication device for direct communication. In addition, the Hospital is establishing ancillary float pools composed of Unit Assistants and NAs to provide additional support to the unit.
