The New York State Office of the Medicaid Inspector General (OMIG) is an independent

office within the Department of Health responsible for the Department's duties with respect to

the recovery of improperly expended Medicaid funds. PHL 31. The OMIG determined to

recover Medicaid Program overpayments from Orchard Manor Rehab. & Nursing Center (the

Appellant). The Appellant requested a hearing pursuant to SSL 22 and former Department of

Social Services (DSS) regulations at 18 NYCRR 519.4 to review the overpayment determination.

The OMIG's determination was communicated to the Appellant by a final audit report

(audit # 13-4290) dated August 8, 2016. (Exhibit 3.) Written notice of hearing in conformity

with the requirements of 18 NYCRR 519.10 was sent to the Appellant on October 11, 2016,

scheduling the hearing to commence on December 14, 2016.

The hearing was rescheduled upon the request and consent of both parties to January 12,

February 23, March 14, and April 20, 2017. On April 20, 2017, the parties appeared, and the

Appellant made a statement on the record at the hearing withdrawing the hearing request.
