

Prescription Drugs Covered by NYS Medicaid for Dual Eligible Members
Effective 3/1/2020

The New York State (NYS) Medicaid program provides prescription drug coverage only for the drugs listed below for members who are also enrolled in a Medicare Part D drug plan. All other prescription medications should be reimbursed through the Part D plan. For the most up to date coverage information for the products below, providers should refer to the NYS Medicaid List of Reimbursable Drugs available at <https://www.emedny.org/info/fullform.pdf>.

NYS Medicaid also covers certain over-the-counter drugs for dual eligible members, if coverage is not available under Medicare.
