We are pleased to inform you that the PPS of Amida Care, Inc. has been awarded a DSRIP Design Grant Award.

The total amount of your award is \$500,000. The award may be paid in one or split into two equal payments at the Department's discretion. The first payment is scheduled for distribution on 8/22/2014 and is for \$250,000. The second payment is scheduled for distribution on 11/03/2014 for \$250,000 will be contingent on the receipt of acceptable deliverables. These deliverables will be to access progress towards the formation of the PPS and will include such items, but not limited to Community Service Need Plan progress, PAC formation and guidelines, governance structure for PPS, etc. A separate collection tool will be provided to you in the very near future to collect this information uniformly for all PPS's.


Additionally, the following conditions specific to Amida Care, Inc. need to be met:

***Conditions: Must resubmit with safety net provider as lead or successfully become a safety net provider through the appeal process. Also must demonstrate that you can function as an Integrated Delivery System.***

This award is intended to provide funding necessary for you to progress the DSRIP planning process. It should not be interpreted as an affirmation of your proposed partnership arrangement or geographic scope of coverage. As additional information becomes available, you should continue to assess the appropriateness of your proposed partnership and coverage area in order to obtain the alignment of provider and community interest that can best achieve DSRIP goals. Where appropriate, planning grant modifications can be made for the purpose of facilitating PPS realignment.
