

# Naloxone Co-payment Assistance Program N-CAP

**Naloxone is an  
emergency medicine  
that can stop an  
opioid overdose.**

Do you have prescription coverage as part of your health insurance plan? If you do, you can use N-CAP to cover up to \$40 in prescription co-payments so there are no or lower out-of-pocket expenses when getting naloxone at a participating pharmacy.

Many New York State pharmacies provide naloxone through a “standing order” which means you can get the medication at these pharmacies without a prescription from your doctor. To find the nearest registered program or participating pharmacy please visit:

# N-CAP Pharmacist Instructions

The N-CAP co-payment reimbursement process is open to any valid prescription or standing order for anyone with prescription coverage. There are no enrollment requirements for individuals.

To participate in N-CAP, pharmacies must use the payer information below and bill each claim as an NCPDP D.0 co-payment only claim, (308-C8=8):
