SPARCS Injury Remediation Project Update



SPARCS Injury Edit Remediation Project

- SPARCS data selected for remediation
 - Discharge years 2018 2023
 - Inpatient and Emergency Department claim types only
 - N0003 and N0002 edits
- Email notification sent to facility coordinators on 7/24/2023
- Started transfer of claim detail files to facilities via HCS
 - Completed transfer of files to 105 facilities out of 211 total
 - Facilities prioritized for transfer by volume of records to remediate
- Facilities must resubmit files with appropriate external cause and/or place of injury codes by 10/31/2023
 - Extensions will be granted if additional time needed



SPARCS Injury Edit Remediation Project

- Compliance Exception or Extension Requests
 - Facility compliance status is not expected to be affected by remediation because records were already accepted by SPARCS
 - Specify that request is related to injury remediation project
 - Exception give specific details for reason that remediation can't be completed
 - Month(s)/Year give specific dates of time period that records are not available to be remediated
 - Extensions give specific reason and estimated additional time needed to complete remediation
 - Do not include PHI in any emails sent to SPARCS



SPARCS Race/Ethnicity Data

- SPARCS uses the US <u>Centers for Disease Control (CDC) Race</u>
 and Ethnicity Code Set to collect data
- SPARCS requires at least one race and one ethnicity on each claim
 - Multiple race and ethnicity codes may be reported
- Select codes which best describe the race and ethnic origin of the patient
 - Facilities should collect and report information as granular as possible
 - Race/ethnicity must be captured through patient (or guardian/caregiver) self-reporting – can not be assumed through physical appearance or preferred language
 - If patients refuse or decline to answer, the only options for SPARCS reporting are R9 "other race" and E9 "unknown ethnicity"
